



In Florida we do not have one Election Day, but we have an Election Season.



First you must be Registered to Vote in Florida by Monday October 5. (Fs.97.055)
You can Register to Vote on line @ <https://registertovoteflorida.gov/eligibilityreactive> or by contacting your [county Supervisor of Elections](#).

People who are registered to Vote in Florida may make changes to a voter's name, address, and signature (Fs.98.077 and 101.454) **and party affiliation for the General Election** (Fs.97.1031) on line @ <https://registertovoteflorida.gov/eligibilityreactive> or by contacting your [county Supervisor of Elections](#).

- Have you changed your Address?
- Have you changed your name by marriage or divorce?
- Has your signature changed?

There are 3 ways to Vote in Florida.



1. Vote-by-Mail: In Florida anyone can request a Vote-by-Mail Ballot. To request one go to your [county Supervisors of Elections' website](#).

The deadline to request a vote-by-mail ballot **to be mailed to you** is 5:00 p.m. (local time) is October 24.

You can pick up your Vote-by-Mail Ballot at your Supervisor of Election Office up to Tuesday November 3rd.

Your vote-by-mail ballot must be **received** in your local Supervisor of Elections Office no later than **7:00 p.m. (local time) on Tuesday November 3rd!**

You can return your Vote-by-Mail Ballot by: U.S Mail, mail as soon as you receive it and fill it out, but no later than Monday October 27th, or you may return it in person to a secure drop box at your Supervisor of Elections' office or at any early voting site in your County. 2. Early Voting: The Early voting period is October 24–31. Your Supervisor of Elections **may** also offer additional early voting days. Please check with your [county Supervisor of Elections](#) website for the early voting dates and locations in your county. **You may Vote at any Early Voting site in your County.**

You may hand deliver your Vote-by-Mail ballot to a secure drop box at any early voting site in your County. You can find the location on your [county Supervisor of Elections](#) website.

During early voting, you will be asked to provide a valid photo ID with signature like Florida driver's license or another ID card with your signature on it.



3. The last Day to Vote in person is Tuesday November 3rd.

Voting Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7p.m. Any voter waiting in line at 7:00 p.m. will have the opportunity to cast a ballot.

To find your local Polling location you can check your Voter Registration Card or contact your local [county Supervisor of Elections](#) website.

On Election Day, you will be asked to provide a valid photo ID with signature like your Florida driver's license or other ID card with your signature on it.

A Vote-by-Mail Ballot may NOT be delivered to a Polling place on Election Day!
