

RESOLUTION NO. 55-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TEQUESTA, FLORIDA, INCREASING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES IN THE GENERAL FUND 2021/2022 BUDGET BY \$2,090.00 TO RECOGNIZE ADDITIONAL REVENUES FROM PALM BEACH COUNTY FOR MANATEE PATROL SERVICES AS WELL AS RECOGNIZING RELATED OVERTIME EXPENDITURES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the General Fund 2021/2022 Budget currently includes \$16,660.00 for manatee patrol services; and,

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County has notified the Village that they are eligible to receive \$18,750.00 in Fiscal Year 2022 for manatee patrol services; and,

WHEREAS, the Village incurs overtime expenditures for the manatee patrol services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TEQUESTA, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 Resolution No. 55-21 is hereby approved increasing revenues and expenditures in the General Fund 2021/2022 Budget by \$2,090.00 to recognize additional revenues from Palm Beach County for manatee patrol services as well as recognizing related overtime expenditures.

Section 2 This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
